



Mobile Crane Certification

NCCER's Mobile Crane Operator Certification Program is formally recognized by OSHA and accredited by the ANSI National Accreditation Board (ANAB). The criteria for the Mobile Crane Operator Certification Program were developed based on current ASME B30 standards, OSHA regulations, state regulations, manufacturer expectations, and employer expectations.

NCCER and its SMEs have participated on various subcommittees to assist in the development of ASME standards. This participation ensures the timely and proper application of these procedures. The wide acceptance of NCCER by many local, state, and national organizations, and by employers of crane operators in many states, is evidence of the cooperation and respect of the institutions and organizations concerned.

NJ Crane Expert is an accredited assessment organization, which is an entity accredited by NCCER to deliver the National Craft Assessment and Certification Program (NCACP) and provide industry-recognized credentials.

Program Details

- This program is for all rubber tire truck mounted cranes
- Candidates will perform a practical exam with the truck type they need to be certified on
- All testing is electronic allow for immediate testing results & scores
- 75 multiple choice question written assessment, candidate must score 80% or higher
- Outdoor practical exam, candidate must score 80% or higher
- Certification is then valid for 5-years
- Recertification requires the operator to take their written and practical exam prior to expiration of their certification
